2024.3 Partner Overview Q&A

Q1: Question on New UI - Is it Instrument UI or the classical UI?

A1: The initiative addressing the modernised UI is about Instrument UI (or referred to as the new UI).

Q2: Is the objective that the classic Web UI will disappear in favor of Instrument UI or can we choose to keep the old Web UI?

A2: You can choose to keep the old Web UI for now. The long-term objective is that the new UI (Instrument UI) will replace Web UI, however we haven't put a date on it yet.

Q3: The auto method completion in external editors is a cool feature. Do we need any specific plugin or just editing in any external editors should support?

A3: Only Microsoft Visual Code is directly supported (free download). No plugins are required.

Q4: As I saw, Al Translation is applicable to PMDM. License (\$) needed? Which translator engine is integrated?

A4: We have added Azure OpenAI as the AI translation tool. Please reach out to your Account Manager for license information.

Q5: Which Al-Engines are used for Al-created texts, translation and image recognition? Are there any 3rd-party tools and licences needed?

A5: The new AI capabilities are built to connect with Microsoft Azure AI components. An Azure AI account would be required prior to using these new features.

Q6: Is 2024.3 still applicable on OnPrem systems?
